- Applied projects in providing trainings and facilitated dialogue on policy for educators; creation of "Policy in Practice" briefs

### GRANT WRITING CLINIC

- Regular meetings with a grant writing team of mentors, graduate students, and youth
- Applied projects in writing grant proposals with community and school partners
